TECHNICAL LEVEL: One of the best aspects of the lecture is the versatility of the material in terms of technical ability required. There is material that will be developed by the most advanced sleight of hand men and there are several items that can be immediately be added to average magicians performance.

STAGE AND CLOSE-UP: The lecture does not limit itself to a single branch of magic. It is divided into 60% close-up and 40% stage material. Recognizing the needs of today's performers, all the material can be done while standing. Several items are professional routining and presentations for routines or gimmick used by most magicians. Other items are entirely unique and original.

As a general rule there are 4-5 items dealing with cards, 6 with coins, and 4-6 items dealing with miscellaneous routines or utility items. The lecture is very well rounded for all stand up performers.

Everything performed in the lecture is completely explained, often with several versions requiring different skill levels.

There will be a free outline provided which will list the lecture effects in the order of their explanation.

There will be a break in the middle of the lecture in order to sell notes. Depending on the length of the break, the lecture will last almost three hours, and will cover 16 items.

Material will be taken from The Command Performance-Premier Issue and Encore I. These are high quality, professionally typeset and illustrated booklets written by MICHAEL AMMAR. They explain in detail the lecture items, as well as many other routines. They sell for \$8.50 through the mail, and \$8.00 at lectures.
