Join Ring members for a Magical Caravan to Branson March 27

Jim Henson is putting together and will lead an all-day trek <u>Sunday</u>, <u>March 27</u> to Branson, Missouri to watch illusionist <u>Kirby VanBurch'</u>s new show.

You may remember we wrote about his show in last September's newsletter. Here are some excerpts from that article:

"We understand there is a major, new theater in Branson featuring Kirby VanBurch, known as both 'The Prince of Magic,' and the 'Master of Illusion.'

"It could be said that VanBurch was already on his way to being a star by his 16th birthday when he was given a Bengal tiger as a present. Already an accomplished young magician, the animal immediately became a part of his act. With the help of an uncle who was an animal trainer, the act gradually grew until it included other wild animals, birds and reptiles.

"Recently Kirby purchased some of the famous illusions of retired magician Doug Henning, including the water levitation illusion. He plans to incorporate more

magic in his show than any show has ever had in Branson.

"Co-starring in the new show at the Five Star Theatre is **Bobby Berosini** and his orangutans. He is the man who trained the orangutan for the movies 'Every Which Way but Loose' and 'Going Ape,' and many television shows."

Jim is proposing that cars which go leave about 8 am in order to arrive late morning. He is trying to arrange lunch with Kirby, before his 2 pm show. If that doesn't work out, then he hopes Kirby will meet with us after the show (which lasts about 2 1/2 hours).

Depending on whether we can meet with him before or after his show, we should be back in Little Rock no later than 9 pm

Jim says he already has eight commitments to go so apparently the caravan is on. If you're interested, call Jim no later than March 19. He will reserve the seats. Cost will include the show, a share of the gas and your own meals.
