#### **TENTATIVE MEETING AGENDA:**

The following is the planned agenda for Ring 29 meetings. We'll try to follow it as closely as possible, but will have to be flexible from time to time.

7 pm Welcome and introductions Ring business; new members

7:15 New Magic Review: A discussion of new tricks people have purchased or have read about. This segment may also include discussion of Web sites, shows visited, etc.

Tricks in Progress: A chance for one or more people to do a trick or technique that they are working on to get feedback and suggestions.

7:45 Opening Routine: A trick which exemplifies the topic of the evening.

Others demonstrate tricks with each person receiving feedback from other members using a feedback sheet.

8:10 Workshop: a basic skill associated with the night's topic is demonstrated and discussed. Other methods may also be presented. Then those who can do it will assist and mentor those who can't or critique each other. This way everyone leaves the meeting with a new skill.

8:25 Raffle: Each meeting there will be a raffle for a magic-related item, costing \$10 or more. Tickets will be \$1 and each person presenting that night will be entered for free.

Closing Routine: 8:30 example of the night's topic but may be done in a different way or with a different approach or presentation.

Let's all give this an honest effort. To make it work please be there on time.




