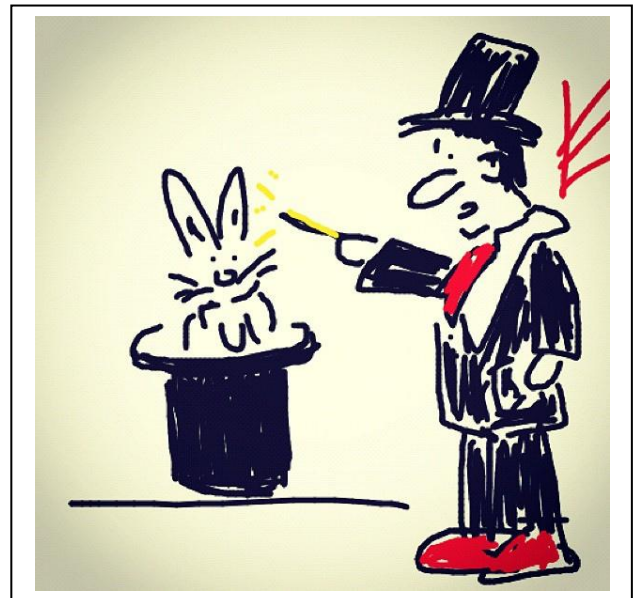

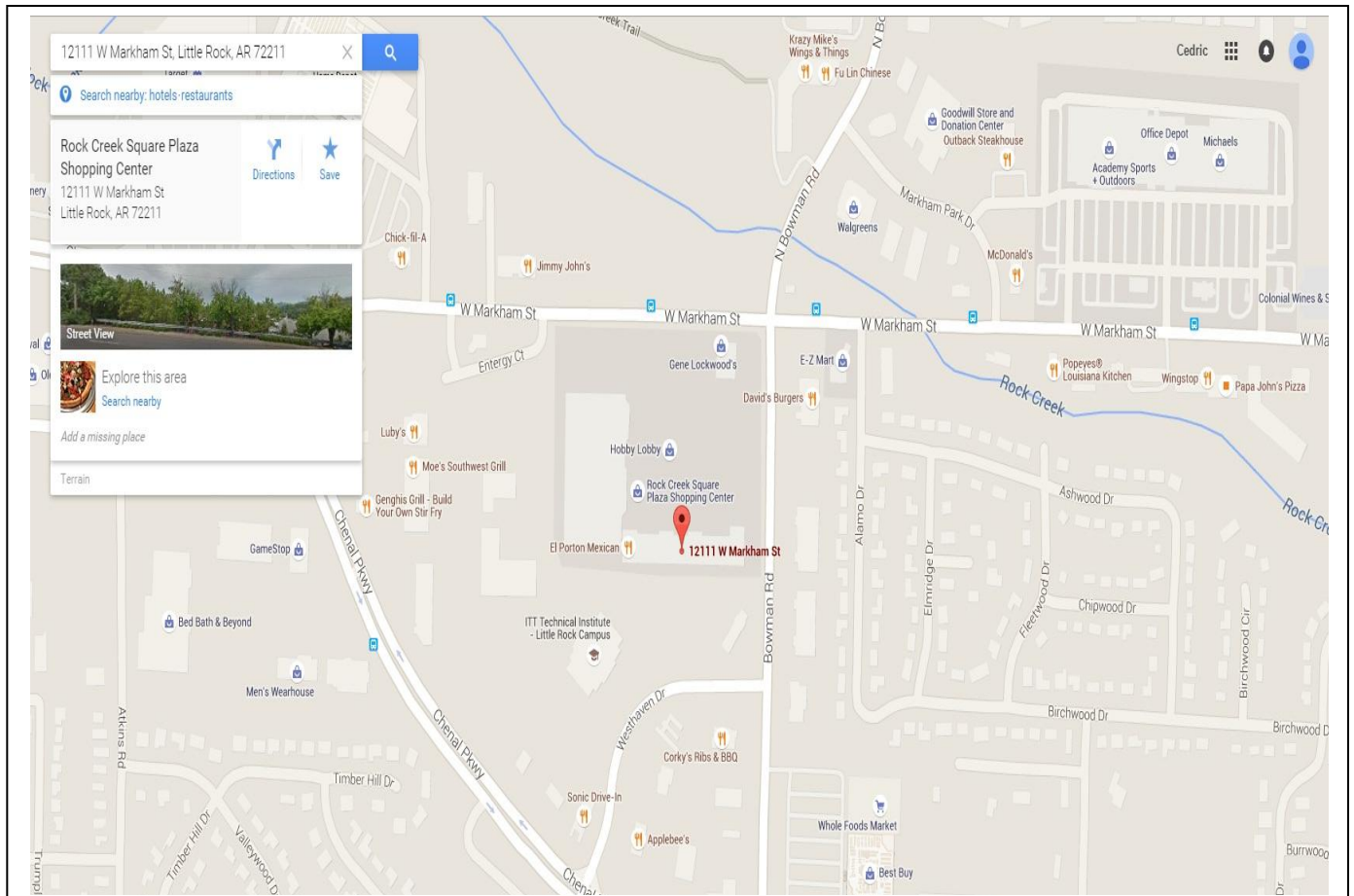
June: Installation Meeting

" Chuck Rubey, visiting from his home in Orinda, CA (510-409-1531), provided an excellent lecture for Ring 29's June meeting. Chuck started his career in magic at age 6, and has focused his attention on red/black card magic.

He showed us a variety of red/black effects with both gimmicked and regular decks, including Stripper and One Way Decks. He demonstrated the Faro shuffle, and presented classic red/black effects including Out of this World and Oil and Water.

Not only did Chuck provide his lecture to our Ring, but he most generously handed out lecture notes, "A Short Treatise on Black & Red Card Magic with suggestions on Supporting Shuffles and Other Techniques" to those in attendance, free-of-charge. Thank you, Chuck!

The business meeting culminated in the re-election of all officers: President, Don Baer; Vice-President, Christy Henson; Secretary, Chris Westfall; Treasurer, James Kinsey; and Sergeant-at-Arms, Gerry Bailey.

We look forward to our annual officers' banquet."

The Ring got "an excellent lecture" and everyone got to take home free lecture notes with a lot of new material to work on. It was a great night for all.

Until next time, think back to the lectures of the past to give you material you can build on for today.

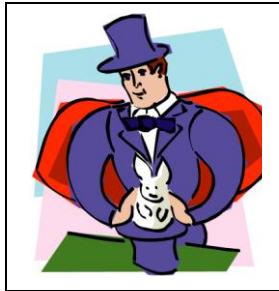

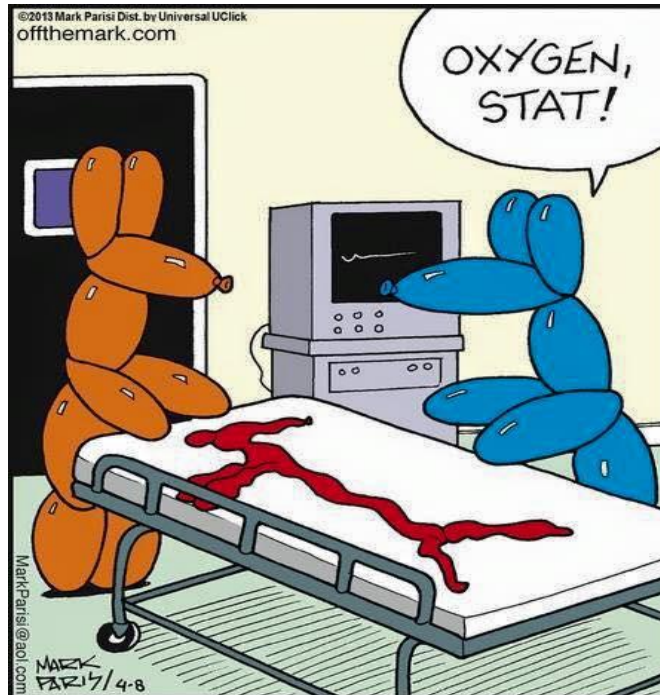
