Presidents Corner

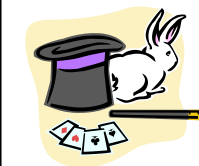

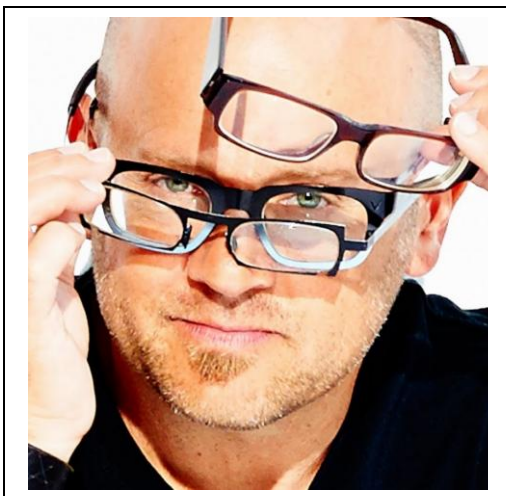

Jim Henson, likewise, has always been there for the Ring, like when it was in need of a video tape machine. Back then those machines weren't easy to come by.

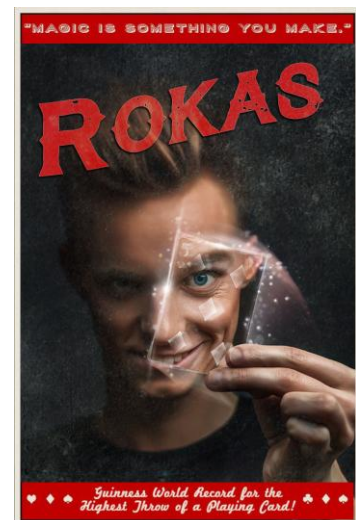

Note from the Editor

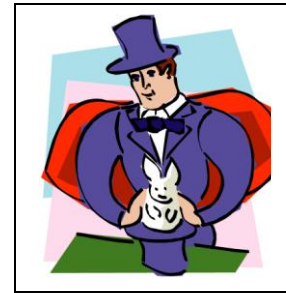

Instead of a lot tricks with cards and coins, Jay will be sharing the secrets to jaw-dropping effects with dollar bills, drinking straws, iPhone cords, bottle caps, sunglasses, finger rings and more. And as with most of his material, the effects are extremely visual, and require very little scripting. For the most part, the tricks are also quite easy to do.

ALL of these elements work together, to free up the performer to focus most of his (or her) energies on what really matters: connecting with people and expressing yourself by HAVING FUN WITH MAGIC!
