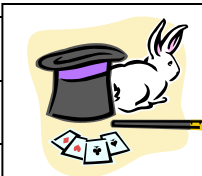
## Ring News

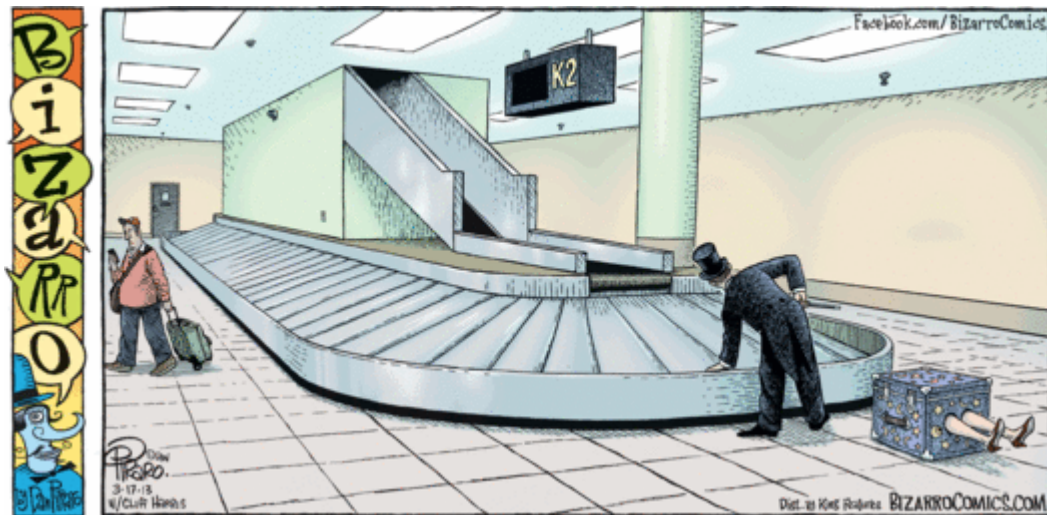
